With the inception of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 Custom Coils has seen a rise in requests for reports on the origin of minerals- specifically tin (Sn), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), and gold (Au) - commonly used in the manufacturing of our product.

These minerals are called conflict minerals because they are found in regions where forced labor and other human rights abuses are used to mine the minerals and finance armed conflict, specifically in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and its adjoining countries (Republic of Congo, Angola, Zambia, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, Uganda, South Sudan and the Central African Republic). The goal of the act is to motivate companies to ensure that the 3TGs used in the manufacturing of their product come from conflict free sources.

During the manufacturing of Custom Coils' product, solder wire and solder bars are used frequently. These items heavily use Tin (Sn) as a component of their makeup. Custom Coils is committed to sourcing responsibly and considers mining activities that fuel conflict as unacceptable. In an effort to map the "Conflict Minerals" supply chain, Custom Coils has generated a CMRT that compounds the Smelter Lists from all of our solder suppliers. Although Custom Coils in not a public company and compliance to the Dodd-Frank Act is not required, this CMRT is available upon request.

Custom Coils will continue to undertake reasonable due diligence within our supply chain to assure that raw materials have not been sourced from a "Conflict Region."
